

The third annual City of Melbourne Teams Championship took place at MISC on 4<sup>th</sup> of November. The basis of the competition is each team has three shooters each firing 60 shots. Shooters can have a wind coach if they wish. The competition has both scratch and handicap matches in both prone and benchrest disciplines. Included in the entry fee is a BBQ lunch for each competitor. Each member of the winning teams receive a memento to mark their victory. Due to a clash with the Cup weekend and the Aus. Cup final in Sydney, some clubs were unable to field a team but nine prone and seven benchrest teams contested this years event.
