Separating of Ties In the event of a tie, the higher placing will be awarded to the competitor that has attended the greater number of competitions up to the allowed maximum of eight. In the event of a tie with two competitors who have attended the same number of competitions, the higher placing will be awarded to the competitor that has gained the greater number of higher placing's at any one or multiple individual competitions throughout the season. For example Shooter A and Shooter B both have a total of 32 points, Shooter A scored 8, 9, 7, 8 and Shooter B scored 9, 10, 7, 6, in this case Shooter B would gain the higher placing due to the 10 points they gained in round 2.
