Gun Check Conducted from 5:00pm Friday and from 7:00am Saturday and Sunday. Grading card and Licence produced upon request. **Medals** Will be presented to 1st 2nd and 3rd for each grade on Sunday.

Entry conditions Juniors entering both adult and junior divisions will shoot only one match (one entry fee will apply) and scores will count for both divisions. If you intend to enter both divisions, please ensure that you are circling the entry form as 'Junior' and 'Women' for 25m Pistol, and 'Junior' and 'Women' or 'Junior' and 'Men' for 10m Air Pistol. Last minute squadding requests, either leading up to, or on the day of the event, will not be accepted.

Special entry conditions MISC is committed to protecting the safety and wellbeing of both members and visitors. In the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, this is achieved by adhering to the Victorian Chief Health Officer's directions and the strict application of the published COVID Safe Rules. In order to maintain everyone's safety, the following COVID Safe requirements shall apply to all competitors, visitors, officials and support personnel. **Subject to change.** 1. Any person with even the mildest of COVID-19 symptoms will be denied entry into the MISC grounds and encouraged to get tested. In such circumstances, a full refund will be provided.

2. Upon entry to MISC each day, every person must fill out the attendance sheet, as well as use the QR code when entering ranges and the clubhouse for prolonged periods. **Please allow for extra time in order to enter details into the QR code system.**
3. Face masks must be carried at all times and must be worn indoors, unless a lawful exemption applies. Face masks are strongly encouraged outside, and when physical distancing cannot be maintained. A decision surrounding masks worn while shooting, or operating every second bay will be made closer to the event date and will be made to ensure that we are aligned with the COVID Rules at the time. This may lead to late notice changes, cancellations etc.
4. 1.5 metre physical distancing must be maintained wherever possible.
5. Hand sanitiser (provided) must be used prior to entering each range, clubhouse and toilets.
6. Range occupancy limits apply. Ranges shall only be accessible to competitors and necessary range staff. Spectators and coaches may not enter the range. MISC COVID Safe requirements are aligned with the Victorian Chief Health Officer's directions and are therefore subject to change. Should circumstances change to the extent that we are prevented from holding the MISC Open, for example due to directions from the Chief Health Officer, MISC will refund/return all entry money. It is therefore important that all EFT transactions are appropriately referenced.
7. A COVID-19 Marshall will be appointed to operate throughout the competition to ensure adherence to these critical safety controls and to protect the safety of all competitors, visitors, officials and support personnel.
