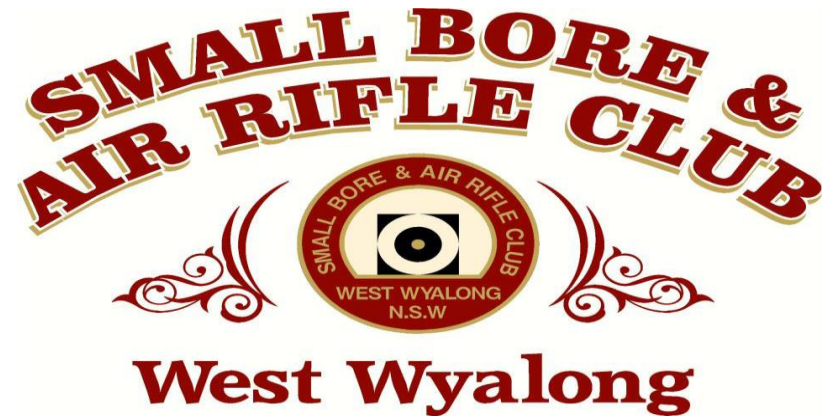

Three Position

All competitors must be entered into the first detail of the 50m Prone match on Sunday.

- The first 20 scoring shots of the 50m English Match Prone on Sunday will be counted as the Prone stage of the Three Position (3P)
- The standing and kneeling stages will continue after the FIRST detail of the 50m Prone Match has been completed
