Prize List

Trophies for all matches will be as per Current TRV Competitions Policy except the following.

1. All WSPS matches, if there are 3 or more competitors: Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. If there are less than 3 competitors will be included in ISSF Open rankings for the appropriate discipline.
2. 50m Prone Open Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded based on qualifying scores.
3. 10m Air Rifle and 50m 3 Position Open Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded based on finals results.
4. State Champion in each discipline is awarded to highest ranking TRV Member based finals results for 10m Air Rifle & 50m 3 Position. For all other events it is based on qualifying score.
