



Interstate Three Position Postal Teams Competition

June 2017 – October 2017



About this Competition

1. The competition is to be a series of half course 3-position (3x20) matches, each match to be shot under ISSF and TRA Supplementary rules.
2. The competition will run in the months of June 2017 – October 2017
3. Each State may enter multiple teams of 3 shooters.

Rules of Competition

1. Teams (members of each team to be named) and reserves will be nominated before the start of the competition. A team member may only shoot in one team for the competition (however, refer to clause 2(e) below). Reserves may shoot in any team to cover absences of team member.
2. Participants are permitted to shoot their cards for each round thus:
 - a. On their own range under supervision of Club Captain, member of their club committee or State Official.
 - b. On a separate range under supervision as in 2a.
 - c. At any competition conducted in Australia under ISSF and/or TRA supplementary rules provided the event is nominated by the shooter as the Postal score before the competition to the appropriate State Official.
 - d. Where a team member shoots a 3 x 40 match in a recognized competition (2c above), the first 20 shot string of each position may be used for this competition
 - e. A state may nominate ONE shooter only to shoot in two teams. The nominated shooter and team members to be advised before the competition commences. The nominated shooter must shoot twice in each month.
3. Cards to be witnessed and signed in accordance with Australian Supplementary Rule A7.8
4. Each State will appoint official scorers for the competition who will score all cards shot in their respective states throughout the competition (notwithstanding rule 2 (c) where the official scorer will verify the score in the competition nominated.)
5. Gauged shots are to be marked and signed by the scorers. All targets are to be retained, un mutilated until after publication of final results at the end of the competition (end of last round). Random checks of cards may be undertaken during the course of the competition. Any competitor shooting on electronic target machines is to provide printed copy of the scoring shots making up the match total. TRA Rule A7.7
6. Scores sheets are to be returned by the 10th day of the following month of the competition round. Failure to return scores by this date will result in a zero score.
7. Each shooter's name is to be clearly shown on the shot targets and score sheet
8. The Competition will be scored on a points basis with the highest scoring team for the month awarded 10 points, second highest score 9 points and so on down to 10th place. In the event of tied scores both teams earn the same points, the next placed team gets two less. (e.g. Teams 1 and 2 achieve the same score 10 points each, next team earns 8 points). A pennant will be awarded to the winning team.
9. Reserves may also shoot each month and will be included in the listing of individual results.
