MISC Anniversary Shoot was conducted on the Port Melbourne range on the weekend on the 19th and 20th of April. For those members who may be unaware of the history of the club the following is a brief resume. Melbourne International Shooting Club was originally formed in 1955 to allow Victorian pistol shooters to own pistols to try to compete in the Melbourne Olympics. To celebrate the founding of the club the Anniversary Shoot was introduced in the early years. When the club was opened up for rifle shooters the club added rifle events to the Anniversary program .

For this year's program the weather was quite mild and some good scores were recorded. For the last few years a match using the Rimfire Benchrest Association has been held on the Saturday. This year 13 shooters tried their hand at it and there were some good scores recorded particularly from those having a go for the first time. The RBA target differs from the TRA target in that you fire 25 competition shots as against the TRA target were you only fire 20 shots. Richard Lightfoot showed his experience to take out the event but was hotly persued by Max Joiner and Vin Anderson only one and three points behind. A 3 position match is also conducted on Saturday. Range staff Reg McCready and Gerry Butler were kept on their toes as a free pistol competition was being conducted at the same time as the rifle match. This is an advantage of the electronic targets that more than one match can be conducted at the same time. Only four shooters contested this match but their scores were up to their usual standard. Saturday also saw the air rifle match conducted. Entry numbers were a little disappointing but some good scores were recorded.

Sunday's matches were the two main ones. 50m prone and 50m benchrest. 26 competitors lined up for the prone match in quite calm conditions. Nerves must have set in as the big guns scored below their averages and it took Oakleigh veteran Mike Jarrad to show how it was done. Shooting a 590, with a nine to finish he won the day from Chris Lott, and in the process set a new Victorian record in the Veteran Class. A pleasing feature of the match was the number of new faces on the firing line and also the number of younger shooters. Some were shooting on the electronic system for the first time and indicated that had enjoyed the experience.

Next door on the benchrest range the competition was much tougher with two 600's being recorded in the first squad to set the pace for the day. Vin Anderson was having a big day. Having shot what turned out to be the winning score he had to rush off back to Kyabram to celebrate his 40th wedding anniversary. At least he got his priorities right. Chief scorer Denis Peacock added a new feature to the results. As cards were scored and loaded into the scoring computer, these results were projected onto a screen so that competitors and spectators could see results almost immediately after a card was scored. The electronic range has a similar feature and the club will endeavour to have it up and running for next year's competitions. The sight of the wind flags hanging limply on their poles must have disconcerted the later squad because nobody could equal the scores from the first squad.

The club would like to thank all those who entered and also all those who assisted in some way to help with the running of the competitions.
