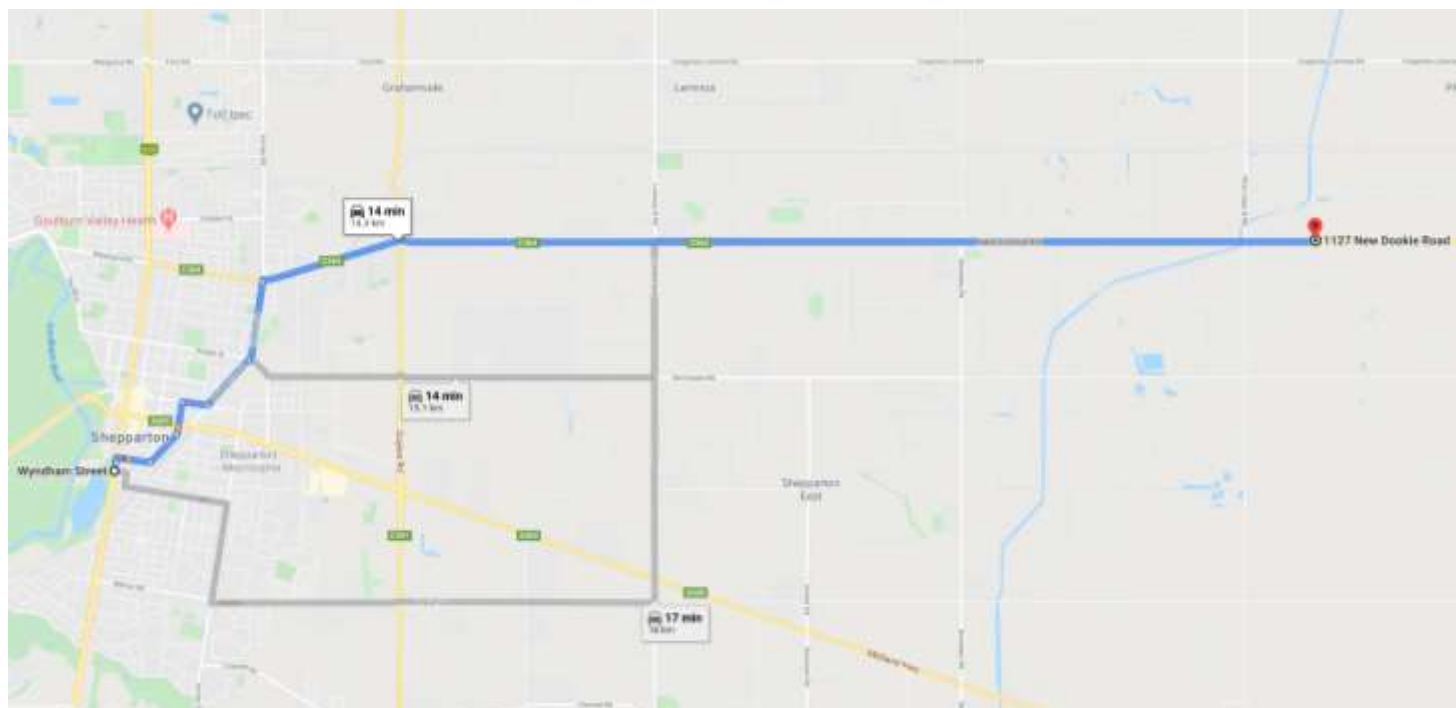

Firearm License and Storage

Secure storage facilities will be available the venue for the duration of the event.
Victoria recognises licenses issued in other States for the purpose of entering a competition.

Extract from Victorian police web site.

Visiting or working in Victoria on a temporary basis

If you hold a firearm licence interstate you can possess, carry and use firearms in Victoria in the following circumstances provided your firearm licence allows you to do the same in your home state or territory:

- Shooting competitions - For taking part in a Victorian shooting competition as a competitor, instructor, referee, supervisor, competition judge or range officer at an approved club or organisation. You may only use a category A or B long-arm or general category handgun. You must carry your firearm licence with you and transport your firearms in a safe and secure manner at all times.

Juniors

Last updated: 14 May 2020

Juniors can obtain a firearm licence in Victoria when they are aged between 12 and 17 (inclusive) but only:

- To carry and use category A & B long-arms, category C long-arms (shotgun only) or general category handguns; and
- In order to receive instruction in the use of firearms or to engage in sport or target shooting competitions; and
- Where they carry and use that firearm under the immediate supervision of an adult with a full licence for the same category of firearm.

A junior licence holder cannot own or store firearms but their parent(s) can apply for a firearm licence to own and store firearms on their child's behalf. Shooting clubs may also loan club firearms out to juniors whilst on an approved shooting range and under instruction.

Victoria Police recommends that licence holders supervising juniors should be within 1 metre of the junior and paying close attention to them in all instances where they possession and/or use of a firearm.

Dear All,

Subject: 2021 TRA National Championships

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) remains a major international concern and continues to have a major impact on sporting events and the economy globally. The health and well-being of Target Rifle Australia members, officials, volunteers, staff and all stakeholders is always our highest consideration when scheduling events in Australia and this matter is heightened due to the continuing situation with the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Board of Directors assures everyone that planning and delivery of next year's 2021 TRA National Championships is continuing and that, at this stage, the 2021 TRA National Championships will proceed as scheduled, from Wednesday 31st March - Monday 5th April 2021 at Shepparton Small Bore and Air Rifle Club, Pine Lodge Recreation Reserve, 1127 New Dookie Road, Pine Lodge, Victoria.

However, it is important to note that this decision is dependent on decisions and actions outside TRA Ltd.'s control, which may be taken by either the Australian Federal Government or the Victorian State Government in respect to the possible closure of sporting venues.

In saying that, the Board of Directors encourages members intending to travel and participate in the 2021 TRA National Championships to take the necessary precautions with respect to their own and others' health and safety when travelling to and engaging in the event.

Consequently, due to the current and ongoing situation with the covid-19 pandemic, border and movement restrictions, a final decision to proceed, postpone, relocate or cancel the 2021 TRA Nationals will be made by 30th November 2020.

For now, the schedule of events and flyer will be distributed as an Expression of Interest for those intending to participate. This document will be distributed as soon as it is finalised.

This has come about via feedback that not all members have been seeing relevant communications and in particular during the pandemic shutdown when clubs are not seeing each other face to face.

As a new member to the sport, I still feel very new to the world of shooting and have much to learn. Shooting was not something I had any interest in. However, when the notion of having rifles on my farm was raised, I decided I wanted to know some basics on how to be safe around 'guns'. After completing my firearms safety course, my fascination was piqued. I was introduced to the Albury Small Bore Rifle Club by a friend who is a member and after going through the club induction process, I found myself signed up and attending the weekly shoots. This was 2 years ago and now I am a fully fledged member, competing in the club competitions and vying for best round within my club each week.



I accepted the TRV committee position to assist in ensuring the association has a varied and diverse representation of the types of members attracted to this sport. I look forward to being an active participant on the committee and assisting in how we navigate the crazy COVID times we have found ourselves in.



TRV Membership Fees

TRV Council has been looking the best way to handle Membership Fees in the wake of the COVID-19 Pandemic. In reviewing our fees we have had the following goals in mind:

- Encourage people to re-join. TRV Membership number are down over 25% on last year.
- Align membership year to calendar year.
- Provide some compensation for the reduced services that TRV as offered during the closures (Pennants, State Champs, Postal Competitions, etc....)
- Provide some compensation for the time people have not been able to shoot.
- Obviously it has been a complicated year and Clubs/Members have been impacted in many different ways. We however, want keep the process as simple as possible.

Proposed Fees Structure

1. For people who have been members in the past but are not currently financial we offering to allow them to re-join before 31 May 2021 for ½ the normal fee.
2. Anyone who is a financial member as at 30 June 2021 will offered renewal to 31 Dec 2021 at ¼ the normal fee.
3. From 1 Jan 2022 fees will return to normal amount and membership year will align to calendar year.

Notes:

Anyone that has already paid the membership fees for 2020/21 year have already had the membership extended till 30 June 2021 effectively giving them three months for free.

This proposal effectively means anyone who is a member as at 31 May the 2020 will end up getting six months membership for free.

Depending on how the pandemic and government restrictions play out TRV Council may make further changes.

Message to all clubs - 2021 Calendar

Although there is no guarantee regarding what will happen with COVID in 2021, we have to plan our calendar of events in the hope that things will return to normal.

If your club is intending to hold either a prize meeting or a postal shoot can you please let me know the dates, so they can be added to the calendar. If you are intending to hold a Master Marksman or Bench Master event, please fill in the form that can be found on the website and return it to the secretary.

If you know of any other event that needs to be included that may not be a club event please let us know these also.

We would like to have the calendar finalised by the end of November and, fingers crossed all events will go ahead as planned.

TRV 2020 50m Prone Pennant

As you will be aware due to the COVID-19 Pandemic this year's 50m Prone it has been severely disrupted. At this late stage in the year it is not going to be possible given government restrictions to complete this event. Therefore, Council has decided to reduce this event to 5 rounds. At the conclusion of round five each team in a section will have shot each of the other teams once only. We are aware that some clubs have shot later rounds however it would not be fair to include these rounds as some teams would have had multiple byes and shot some of the teams twice.

If at the end of round 5 teams in the same section tied both teams will be awarded Pennants this year.

Entry into the 2021 50m Prone Pennant will be free. Entry form will be attached to the newsletter and is also available on the TRV Website (<https://trv.org.au>)

Also, if you would like any prizes sent, you will need to provide a postal address.

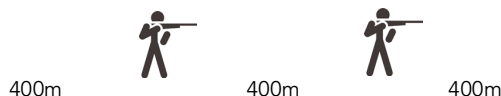

If you have not had this passed onto you via your club please check with your club delegate and advise the Secretary if your club has not been receiving these updates to ensure that we have the correct club contact for you.

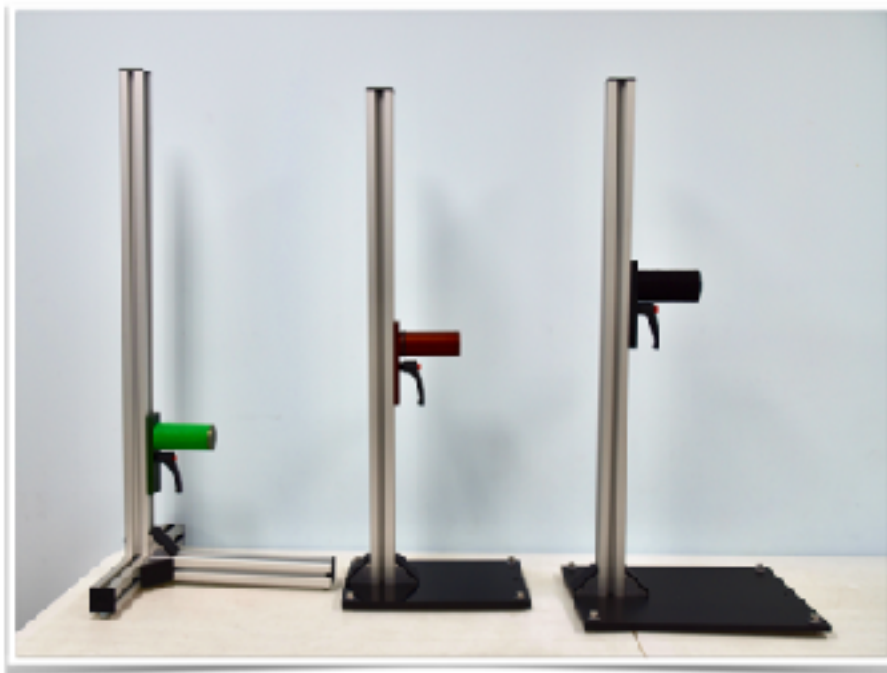
